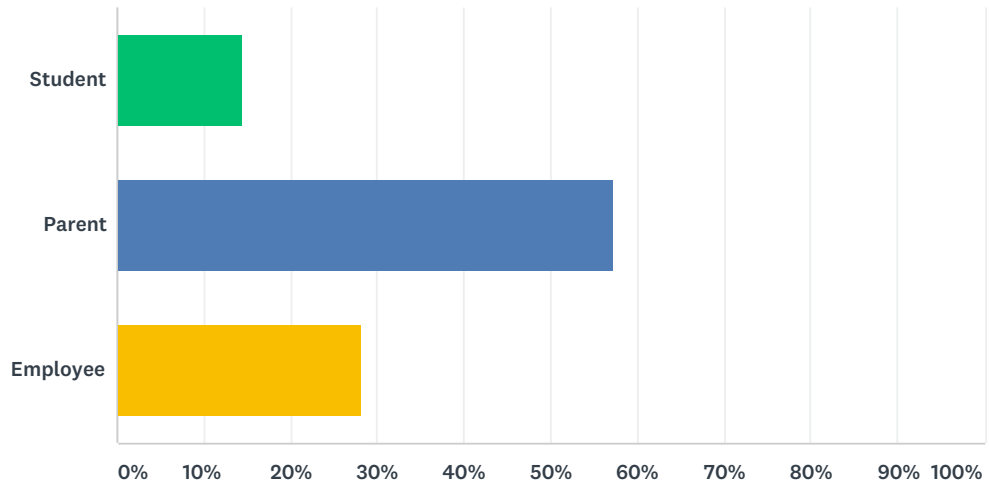


Q1 What is your role within the Crawford Co. R-II School District

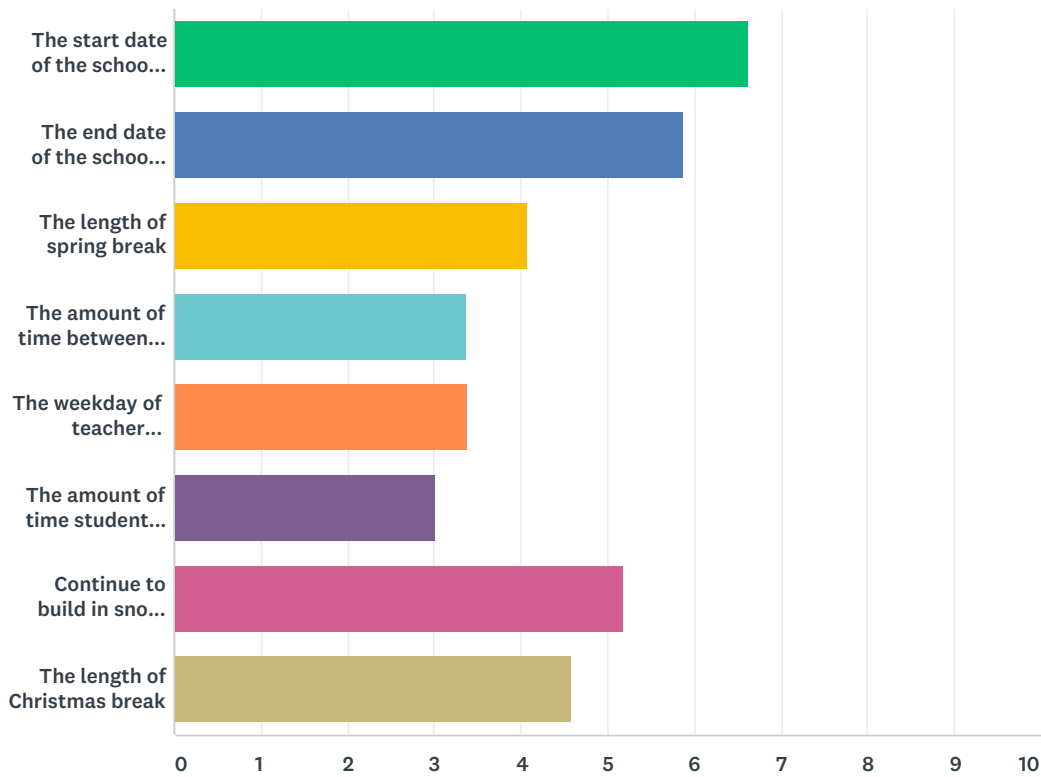

Q2 What issue do you feel is the most important issue when creating the school calendar (Please rank in order of importance from 1-8)

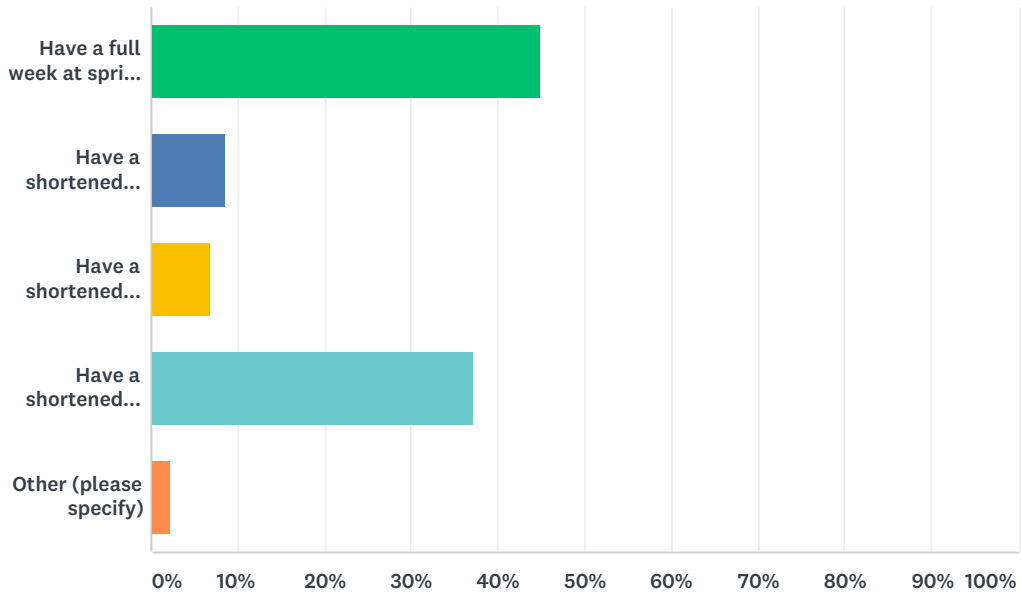

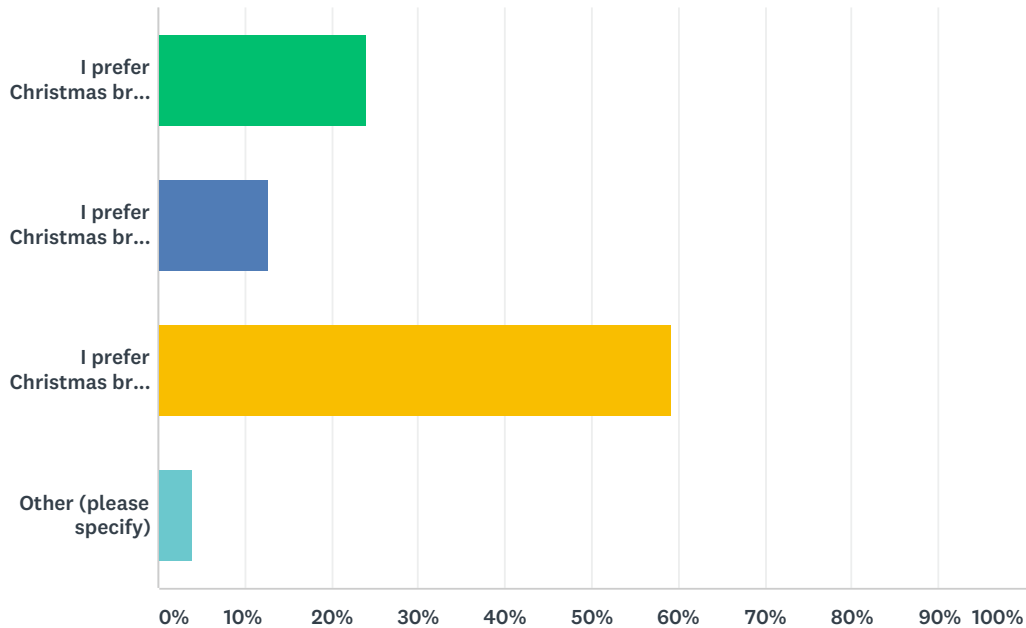

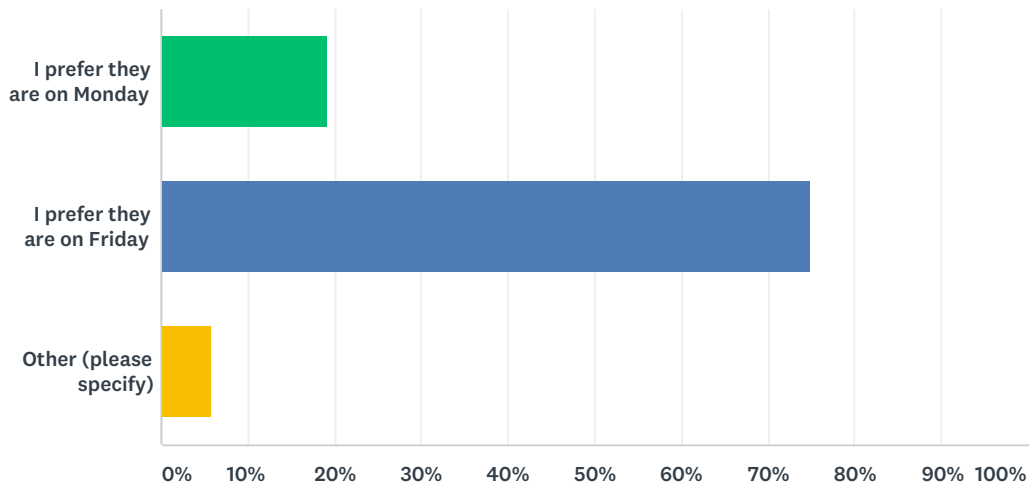

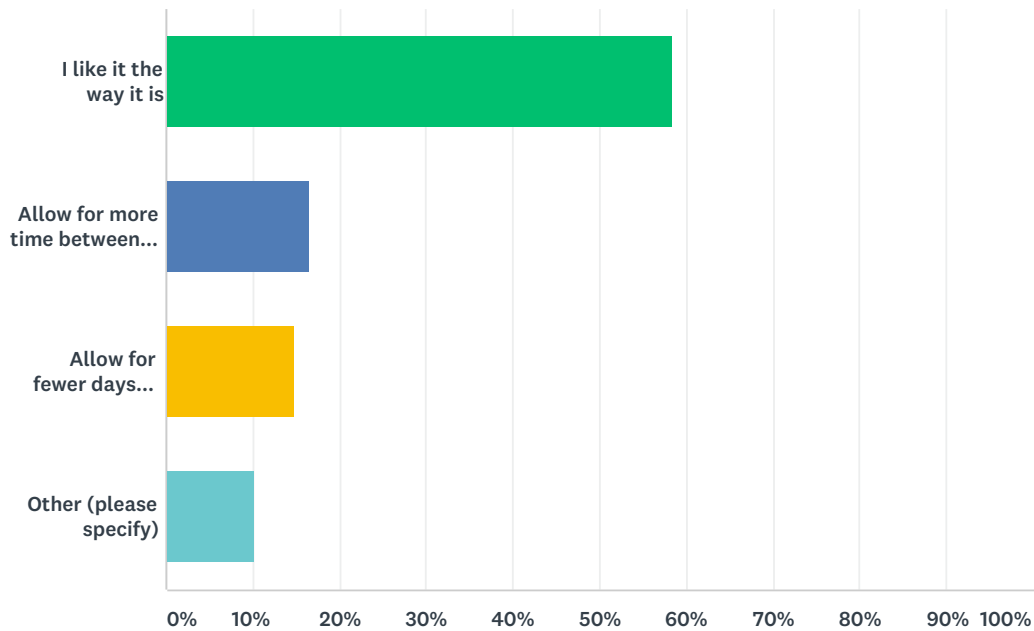

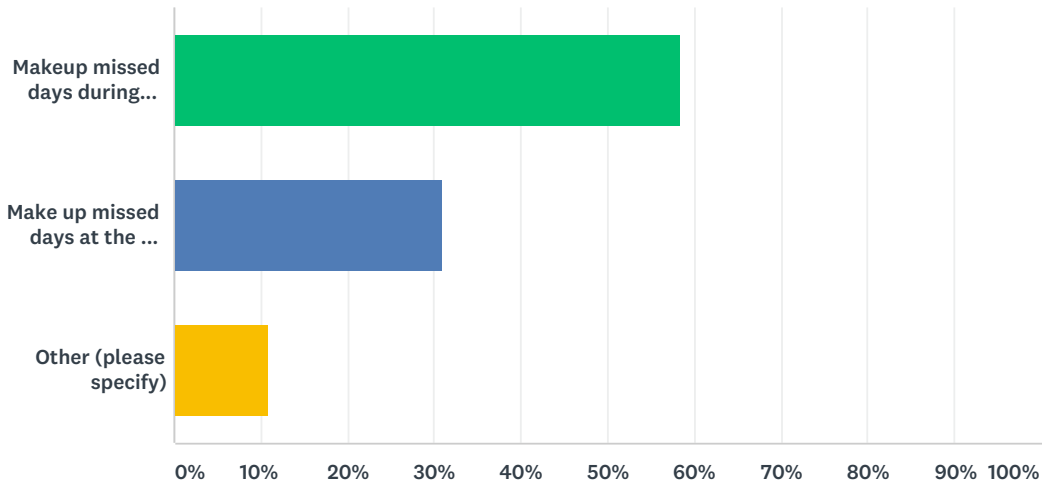

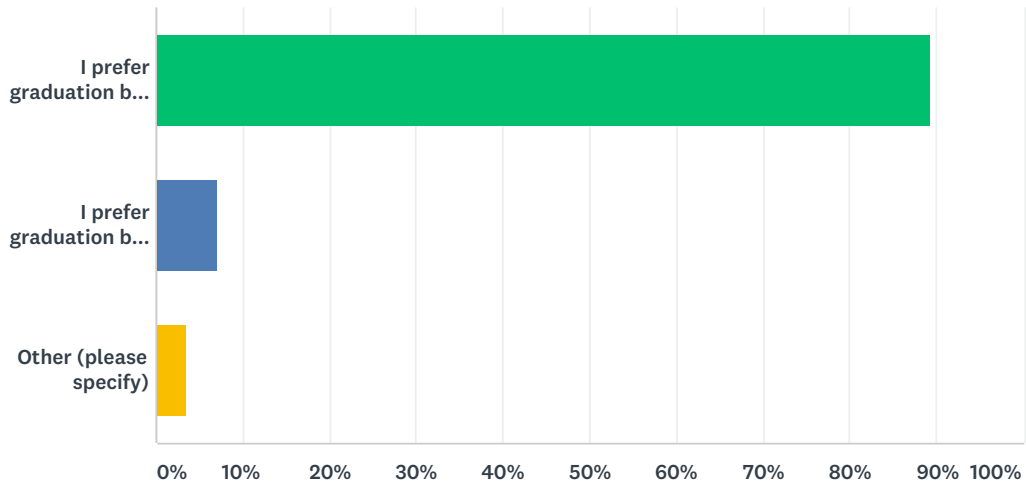

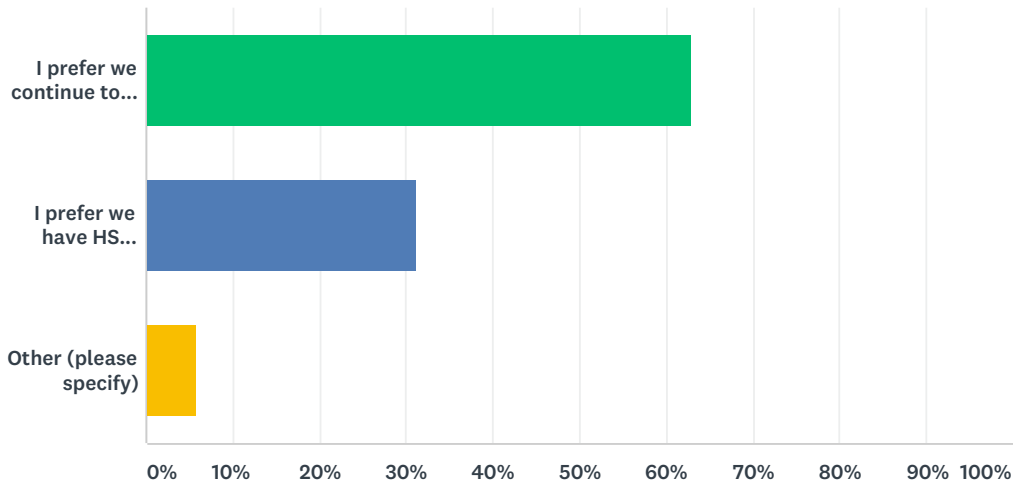

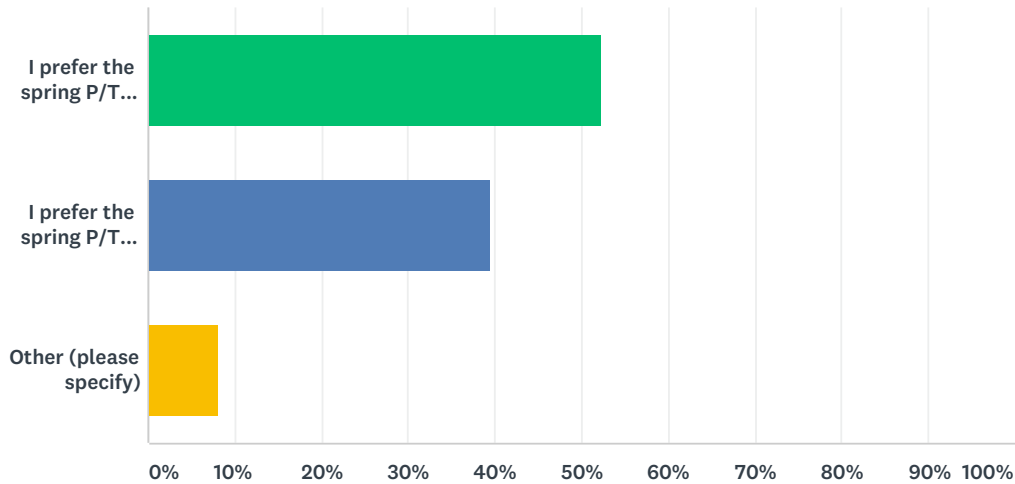
