

Frequently Asked Questions

What does the program cost?

The program is free to all students.

When will the summer school program be held?

The Crawford County R2 Summer school program operates daily beginning May 26 and ending on June 29. Classes begin at 8:00 AM and end at 2:50 PM.

Students are able to enter the building at 7:50 AM.

Official dismissal for the day is 2:50 PM.

What will my student do during the day?

Students will engage in academic skill work that prepares them for the upcoming school year. The morning academic blocks will focus on skills aligned to Missouri Learning Standards. The afternoon academic blocks will be enrichment and intervention using a variety of small group projects and engaging activities.

Brain breaks and physical activity are strategically placed throughout the day.

Can my high-schooler earn credits towards graduation?

High School students may earn credits towards graduation through the credit recovery program as in years past. Additionally, HS students have the opportunity to earn .5 credit towards graduation requirements by enrolling in Health, PE, and/or Personal Finance. *Students enrolled in for-credit courses (PE, Health, Personal Finance) may only miss 2 days in order to gain credit.*

Will transportation be provided to and from summer school?

Yes, transportation will be provided for those who qualify for transportation during the regular school year. However, bus routes will be limited and may vary from regular-year routes. Transportation information will be communicated directly to those families who require transportation as soon as the plan is available.

Will breakfast and lunch be served each day?

Breakfast and lunch will be served daily. Breakfast and lunch are free to all students as well as anyone 18-years old or younger. Breakfast will be available at the door for students to take to the classrooms; the cafeteria will be used for lunch.

Will there be an incentive program?

Students will have the opportunity to win prizes as incentives for their efforts through a daily drawing or some similar format established in each building. However, an attendance incentive will not be available.

If a student is ill, they should stay home until well.

How do I enroll my child for summer school?

Simply fill out the enrollment form. Forms can be downloaded and printed from the school website under 'PARENTS' then 'Summer School Information'. Forms may be picked up at your student's office. Forms should be returned to the applicable office by May 12.

Does my student still wear a mask?

CCR2 will continue to follow CDC and County Health guidelines. Please anticipate students wearing a mask on buses, in hallways, and whenever 6' social distancing is not possible.
