Parents and/or guardians,

Summer school will be **May 26 through June 29, 2021**. Our intention is to provide an academic, fun, and safe learning environment for student. Things will again operate, function, and look different.

Doors will open at 7:50 AM in all buildings with classes beginning at 8:00 AM. Breakfast will be available in grab'n go form at the entrance. All students will report directly to their classroom. Lunch will be served in the cafeteria. Students will be **dismissed for the day at 2:50 PM**.

New for Summer 2021, all academic **curriculum used will be developed locally by our own teachers** and will target specific needs of our students. Mornings will focus on core academic learning standards to assist in preparing students for the next grade level. Afternoons will continue with academic learning in a less traditional, more open approach. Individual physical activity and brain breaks will be interjected throughout the day.

Transportation is currently scheduled to be provided as in past summer school sessions. This means we will run a limited set of routes. However, **any student living within 1-mile of the school buildings will be required to provide their own means of transportation**. This means any student living south of the railroad tracks and just west of Highway 19 will not be transported by school bus.
